#### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT


This term promises to be a busy one, so thank you for staying up to date and sending back information required promptly.






#### **SCHOOL BANKING**


# THE MUSIC BUS IS NOW TAKING NEW STUDENT ENROLMENTS
