Costa Toparis is off to the world karting championships and credits his success to his family, his mechanic and his supportive teachers at Goulburn West Public School.

Costa recently took out the Australian under 13 Karting Championship and will now compete in Brazil in the Rotax MAX Challenge Grand Finals from 24 November to December 1.

Costa, who is just 11 and competing against racers up to two years older, said taking out the Australian title was a great feeling.

"It was huge. It was just the best feeling you could imagine," he said. We have really worked hard, racing and practising every weekend and making the best of every opportunity." Year 5 student Costa credited his school for its support while he pursues his racing dream. "I try to miss as little of school as I can, and the school has been really accepting of the time I have to take off to race," he said. "I love the work and I love talking to and being with my friends. My teacher has been really helpful in making sure I keep up with the work." Principal Annette Broadbent said Costa was an outstanding student, and a humble boy with a great future. "Costa is in the school's Opportunity Class and is an excellent student," she said. "He is the Regional Public Speaking Champion and is involved in a lot of school activities. "Costa's family is very committed to his schooling as well as his racing career. They appreciate that school comes first. "The school has worked with Costa and his family due to the time Costa needs off school to travel around the country to compete in karting. "His class teacher sets him work and we have granted him partial exemption with the proviso that his work is completed and his grades remain consistent, which he has been able to do. "We're delighted to be able to support him at school and in his racing endeavours." Costa said his speech for the Public Speaking Competition about 'My Future' was, of course, about racing cars "One day I hope to be able to be a Formula One driver," he said. # Year 2/3 Recorder Excursion




NB. Some teachers will not send the coupons home – they will hand them out on the day.

#### Want your child to keep reading throughout the holidays?

Goulburn West has an e-book collection that can help with that! This electronic service means that students can borrow books from anywhere at any time from any device.

With 30,000 books available from 500 New Zealand and Australian publishers (in addition to 270,000 international titles), there is a book for every student of every age.

To download eBooks from home follow three simple steps:

Search for and download the ePlatform by Wheelers app from the app store

Find the Goulburn West library and login using your DET student ID

Browse and borrow an eBook on your device

To make it easier for students, the eBooks have also been uploaded into the Goulburn West 'OLIVER' library catalogue. Students can simply go to their student portal, click on the 'OLIVER' library icon at the top of the screen and borrow eBooks directly from our library.

The eBooks are distinguishable by the tablet/iPad icon beside them in the catalogue list. The books will automatically be returned after two weeks. Students can borrow books again as long as they are still on the virtual shelf and have not been borrowed by someone else (just like in a physical library).

Primary school books have been selected for our school. Year levels, suggested age groups or descriptive blurbs



Violin lessons at Goulburn West Public School




In 2018, Geoff Stewart-Richardson will be continuing the strings programme at Goulburn West Public School. Geoff is an experienced string teacher.
