SUPERVISION BEFORE 8.50am

Our school staff are only on duty from 8:50am and therefore students are not to come to school before then. Recently we have found students coming to school and waiting in the playgrounds by themselves in the morning. Please ensure you drop your child off to school between 8:50am and 9:20am. In 2021, GWPS will be looking at introducing a new way to ensure safety for students who arrive before 8.50am in partnership with our OOSH provider. We are considering, if students arrive before 8.50am who do not catch a bus, they will be sent to OOSH for a casual day which would include a fee for their service.

The school is monitoring and reviewing considerations for children who catch buses to school.

WHAT WORKS BEST

Our school is committed to ensuring that *how* we teach your child is based on what we *know* makes the biggest difference to their learning. In our school, we have a focus on using the 'What works best' eight practices for effective teaching.

These practices include:

- Having high expectations of your child.
- Using explicit teaching in the classroom.
- Giving effective feedback to your child on their learning.
- Using data to inform how we teach your child.
- Using regular and effective assessments so we know how your child's learning is going.
- Supporting the wellbeing of your child by looking out for their mental, physical and emotional health.
- Managing the classrooms well so they are safe, positive and stimulating environments for learning.
- Making sure our teachers collaborate with each other, and experts outside the school, so teaching practice continuously improves.

In addition, research shows that greater levels of support and engagement from parents and carers are associated with better student academic and wellbeing outcomes. We also know that students learn more effectively when the home and school environments form complementary and supportive roles for learning. It is for this reason that we are focused on continuing to foster the partnership between our school and parents.

The Department of Education has now released a 'What works best' resource for parents and carers, which provides tips for having conversations with your child about their learning. You can visit the department's Parent Hub where you'll find other tailored resources for parents and carers, as well as message from the NSW Minister for Education the Hon. 

2021 School Dates

The Department of Education announced a change to Staff Development Days for 2021 and beyond. Commencing at the start of 2021, the changes include:

- an increase from one to two SDDs at the commencement of Term 1
- a decrease from two to one SDDs at the end of Term 4.

The School Development Days are scheduled for the following dates:

27 and 28 January, students return 29 January 2021.

The two SDDs at the start of Term 1 are mandated and cannot be rescheduled. Principals may continue to vary SDDs that fall at the beginning of Terms 2 and 3, and at the end of Term 4.

There will be no changes to:

- the total number of SDDs remaining at five days
- the length of the school year for staff or students (students will start and finish the school year one day later)
- SDDs occurring at the commencement of Terms 2 and 3.
